FORMS OF DETERIORATION AFFECTING FIN DE SIÈCLE PERIOD STAINED GLASS WINDOWS IN THE CARPATHIAN BASIN. PROBLEMS RELATED TO THEIR PRESERVATION AND RESTORATION. RESTORATION IN THEORY AND PRACTICE

Summary

In my thesis I look at the special techniques used to make stained glass windows in the Carpathian Basin in the fin de siècle period and the types of damage these stained glass windows are prone to. Backed by thirty years of professional experience and research I attempt to explain the problems occuring during the preservation and restoration of these works of art. To meet current international standards, in the last part of the paper I discuss the restoration process - works restored being used for illustration. My choice fell on this era due to the fact that it is a period which has been unexplored so far. Restoration methods that suit stained glass windows from this period are taught only at very few universities, in spite of the fact that their restoration is becoming increasingly more urgent. The thesis is intended mainly for university students, people working in conservation and restoration and architects who would like to know more about the theory and practice of stained glass window restoration.
